Patriot Exhibition Fact Sheet

What is the time commitment for a panel member?

Approximately 3 hours. Please check in between 11:45 am and 11:55 am. You will be assigned to a panel in one of our classrooms. Student exhibitions begin at approximately 12:00 noon and you will be done no later than 3:30 p.m. We will serve light snacks and water to panelists.

What is my role as a panel member?

You will listen to the student's presentation and fill out an easy to follow evaluation form (rubric). This provides the students with written feedback about their presentation. A staff member will lead the panel and be able to answer your questions. Panel members are asked to wear business attire to Exhibitions – students will be dressed professionally for their presentations.

Can my evaluation keep a student from graduating?

Scores given by all panel members are averaged and an overall score is assigned to a presentation. A minimum score is required to meet the criteria set by the district.

Will I be able to interact with the students?

You will ask each student questions from a list of prepared questions. While time is limited you will be able to ask additional questions for clarification during the presentation.

Who will see the evaluations?

The student will receive the evaluation. Scores from the evaluations will be averaged and retained by the site.
